About the project

Family Footprints is an Erasmus+ project that began in February 2022, and will end in January 2024. This project focuses on building the digital and climate literacy skills of families, namely children, parents, and grandparents to help support the dual transition of Europe and encourage families to manage their carbon and digital footprints.

- A Family Learning Toolkit composed of Comic Strips, Interactive Magazines, and Audio Books.
- In-Service Training Programme for Adult Educators
