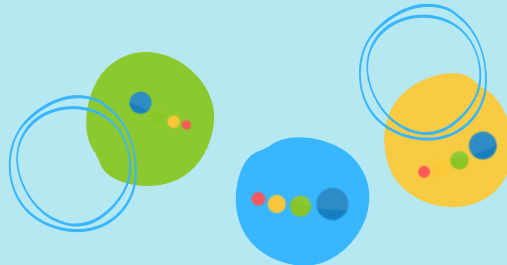

What's new?

The Family Footprints project has reached the end of its first year! We are now moving into the remaining 12 months of the project, and we have reached the following milestones:

- Partners have completed the first draft of the content in English for PR1, PR2, & PR3.
- The draft content for PR4 in English will be completed at the end of January 2023.
- Partners completed the stakeholder testing of PR1, PR2, and PR3 in November 2022.
- Partners have attended online meetings to ensure project tasks are up to date.

Project Results

- **PR1-** Induction to Pedagogy Programme for Parents to support their role as facilitators of family learning in a family learning model.
- **PR2-** A Digital and Climate Literacy Programme for Parents comprising 12 short modules and addressing two core subject areas: digital literacy, and climate literacy.
- **PR3-** A Family Learning Toolkit comprising Comic Strips for children, Interactive Magazines for teenagers, and Audio Books for seniors.
- **PR4-** In-Service Training Programme for Adult Educators.

What's next?

The project coordinator, The Rural Hub, has begun preparing for the Virtual Multiplier Event (VME), that will take place online in the coming weeks. To organise this event, TRH, and all consortium partners have each invited 5 adult educators from their networks with an interest in the project to join this event. This VME will allow adult educators from each partner country to come together, review, and evaluate the project results. Following on from this event, partners will work with TRH to establish a Community of Practice of adult educators, to support the sustainability of the project results.
