The mission of the Family Footprints project is to support all European families through the “Dual Transition” to a more digitally inclusive and environmentally friendly future. The project was developed by a team of 7 partner organisations from 7 EU countries, namely Ireland, Portugal, Czechia, Poland, Croatia, Germany and Sweden.

The project team implemented the project for 24 months and now the project is ending. Educational experts and the general public have at their disposal a wide range of educational tools that have been developed within the framework of the project. The educational tools developed as part of the project are intended for all family members, from small children to grandparents. All educational tools were pilot-tested and evaluated directly by the target groups. Among the most successful tools were comics for children.

- Induction to Pedagogy Programme for Parents to support their role as facilitators of family learning in a family learning model.
- A Digital and Climate Literacy Programme for Parents comprising 12 short modules and addressing two core subject areas: digital literacy, and climate literacy.
- A Family Learning Toolkit comprising Comic Strips for children, Interactive Magazines for teenagers, and Audio Books for seniors.
- In-Service Training Programme for Adult and Community Educators.
